What we collect

We may collect the following information:

- name and job title
- contact information including email address
- demographic information such as sex, age, postcode, preferences and interests
- other information relevant to customer surveys and/or offers
- social media accounts

What we do with the information we gather

We require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, and in particular for the following reasons:

- No information that we receive will ever be given to any third parties.
- We will never sell your information.
- Internal record keeping.
- We may use the information to improve our products and services.

Security

How we use cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyze web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyze data about web page traffic on our websites and improve our website in order to tailor it to our listeners needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website, by enabling us to monitor

which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.
